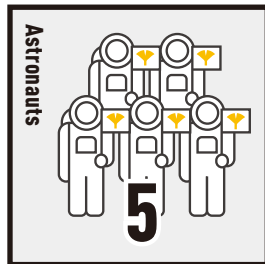
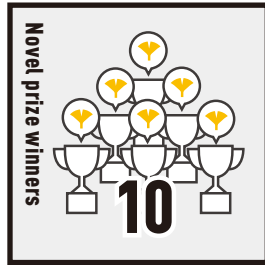
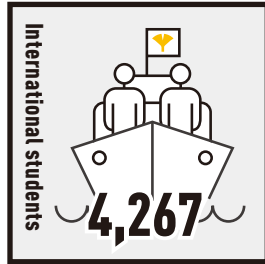


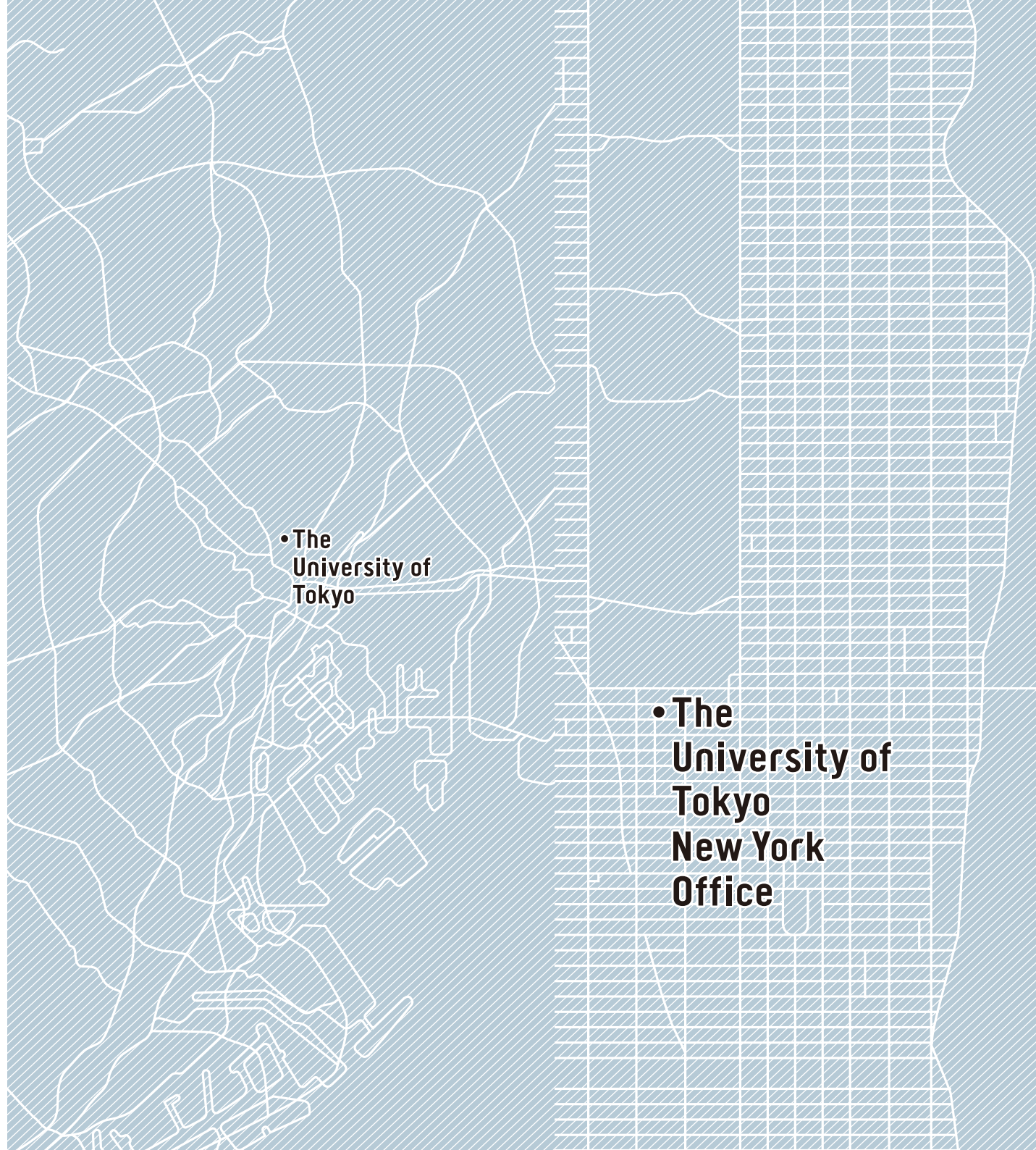
# The University of Tokyo

in the heart of Manhattan

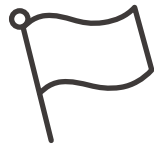
As a major academic and global institution, the University of Tokyo's mission is to contribute to society and people worldwide through pioneering research and education.

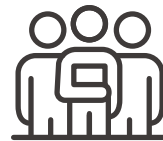
